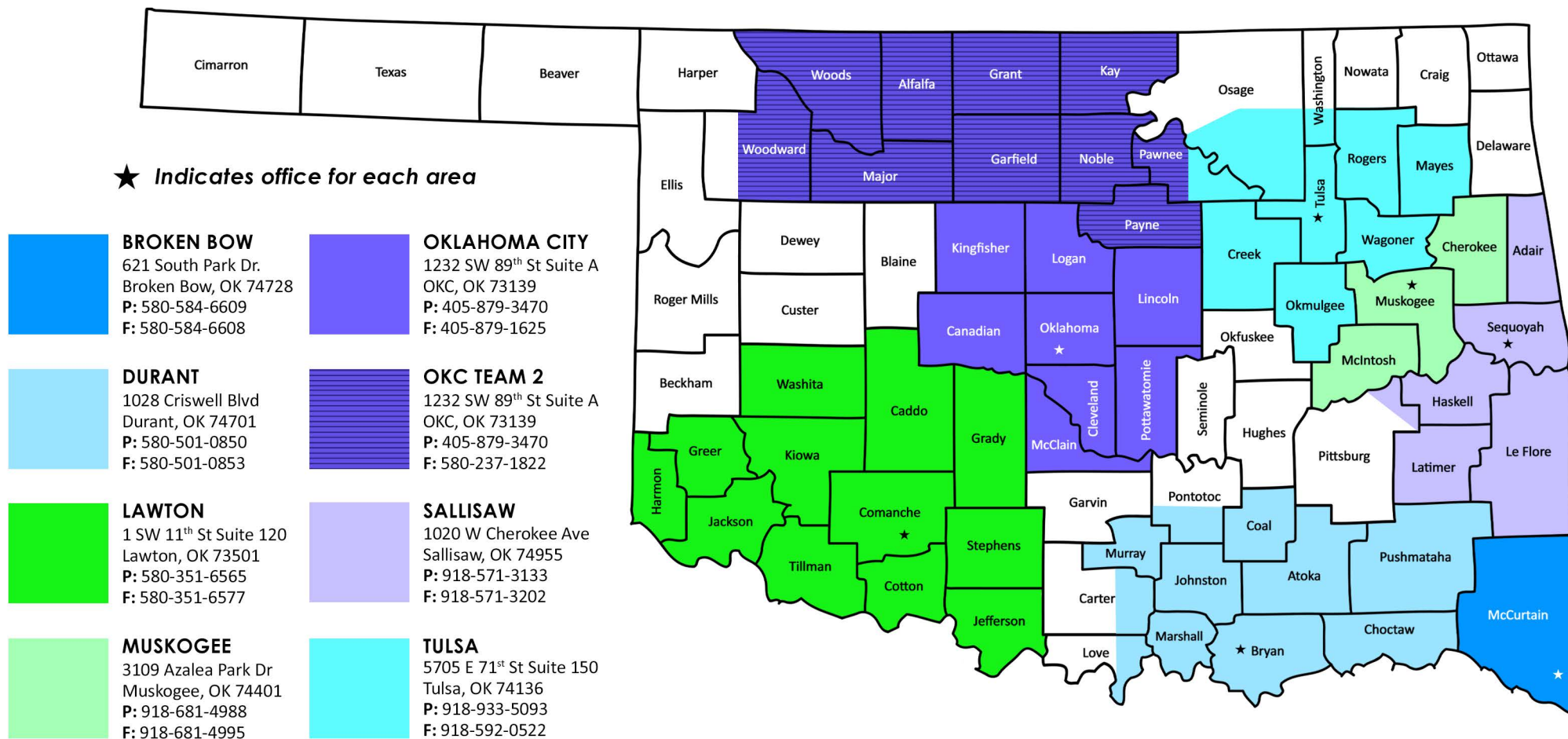

WE PROVIDE

CompleteOK provides whole-person care for individuals with life-limiting illnesses. The hospice plan of care provides 24/7 emergency on-call, medications associated with diagnosis, as well as medical equipment and supplies.

INTERDISCIPLINARY TEAM

- **MEDICAL DIRECTOR:** The Medical Director oversees the hospice care team and can work with the patient's primary provider to monitor the progression of the illness
- **NURSES:** Hospice nurses administer medications, seek to control pain, and provide guidance and education to the patient and family
- **SOCIAL WORKER:** The social worker advocates for the patient's final wishes and provides emotional support as well as logistical support
- **CHAPLAIN:** Hospice chaplains help meet the spiritual needs of the patient and family
- **CERTIFIED AIDE:** Hospice aides provide daily personal care for the patient and may assist with meal prepping and light housekeeping
- **VOLUNTEERS:** Hospice volunteers provide companionship for the patient and provide breaks for the family or caregivers
- **BEREAVEMENT COUNSELOR:** Bereavement counselors provide individual or group counseling to help family members cope with the loss of a loved one in a healthy way

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
