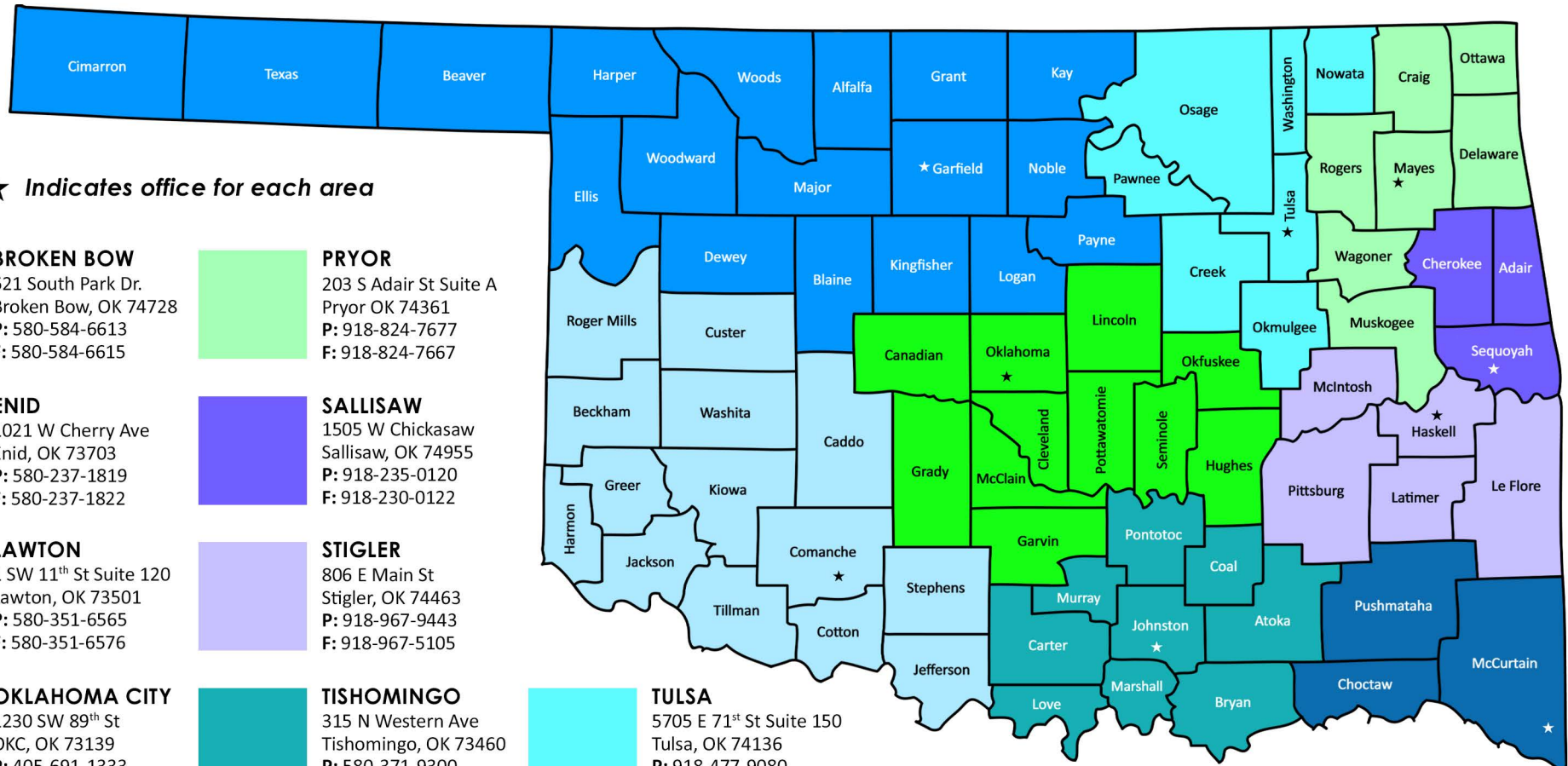

## HOME SERVICES & PROGRAMS

### PROGRAMS & SERVICES

**ADVANTAGE PROGRAM:** The ADvantage Waiver Program is for adults over 21 who have physical disabilities without intellectual disabilities/cognitive impairments.

*Paid for by Medicaid ADvantage Waiver*

- RN Assessment Evaluation
- Case Management
- Transitional Case Management
- Skilled Nursing
- Respite (2-7 hrs) /Expended Respite (8+ hrs)
- Personal Care
- Advanced Supportive/Restorative care
- Hospice Care

**VETERANS PROGRAM:** The Veterans Homemaker Program provides in-home care and assistance with activities of daily living.

*Paid for by Veterans Administration*

- Grocery Shopping, Cooking, Eating
- Bathing and Getting Dressed
- Cleaning and Doing Laundry
- Taking Medications
- Getting to Appointments
- Using the Phone/Computer
- Paying Bills
- Budgeting and Managing Money

**MEDICALLY FRAGILE PROGRAM:** The Medically Fragile Program allows eligible recipients access to services at home, rather than in a hospital or skilled nursing unit.

*Paid for by Medicaid*

- Advanced Supportive/Restorative care
- Case Management
- Respite Care
- Skilled Nursing
- Private Duty Nursing
- Self-Direction Services
- Hospice Care
- Therapy Services

**LIVING CHOICE PROGRAM:** Money Follows the Person is a federal program designed to transition individuals with disabilities/long-term illnesses from institutions back into their homes in the community. The Living Choice Project is Oklahoma's name for the MFP grant.

*Administered by Oklahoma Health Care Authority*

- Personal Care
- Self-Direction Services
- Case Management
- Skilled Nursing

**COMPANIONSHIP SERVICES:** Companions may help with certain household chores, but their primary purpose is to spend time with the patient.

*Private Pay*

- Transportation
- Reading Books Aloud
- Playing Games
- Taking Walks Outside
- Writing Letters
- Monitoring the Home

**HOMEMAKING SERVICES:** Homemaking services extend from companionship by including tasks such as cleaning, cooking and shopping.

*Private Pay*

- Personal Care
- Laundry
- Cooking
- Taking Out the Garbage
- Household Organization
- Respite Care
